PUNCTUALITY AND ATTENDANCE

Punctuality and attendance are much more than mere disciplinary rules; they are a direct reflection of our **Values**, one of the fundamental pillars of our school community.

By cultivating the habit of being present and arriving on time, pupils demonstrate **respect** for their teachers' work, **consideration** for their classmates, and a **commitment** to their own personal development.

These behaviours shape character and prepare young people for the challenges of the future, turning **responsibility** and **civic-mindedness** into daily practices that extend beyond the classroom.

For this reason, students are expected to arrive in the classroom on time every day, so as to ensure they make the most of every learning opportunity.

Systematic absences disrupt the school routine and seriously jeopardise academic success.

It is essential to be aware that **excessive unauthorised absences can directly affect progression to the next year**, putting at risk all the progress made throughout the academic year.

To safeguard the student's progress, attendance is monitored. Consequently, absences for health reasons must be formally justified by means of **medical declarations**.

Furthermore, it is important to emphasise that **absences due to holidays during the school term are not justified**, as the school calendar is designed to ensure that learning objectives are fully met.

UNIFORM

At Escola Internacional de Torres Vedras, the use of school uniforms plays a key role in fostering a **sense of community** and **promoting equality amongst pupils**, thereby minimising socio-economic distinctions within the learning environment.

By organising uniforms by stage - distinguishing between Nursery, Pre-School and “Ensino Básico” (Grade 1 to 9), Primary and Lower Secondary pupils - the school also fosters a sense of **belonging** and **pride** in each pupil’s development.

Although students in **Secondary (National)** and **Upper Secondary (Cambridge)** are free to choose their own clothing on a day-to-day basis – provided it is appropriate – the school’s visual cohesion is universally maintained through the physical education kit and the formal uniform, which are compulsory for all year groups.

This school identity takes on added significance when pupils take part in **school trips, contests or external events**, the uniform acts as a **recognisable brand image**, conveying a message of organisation, respect and a strong connection to the school.

As well as facilitating **safety** and the **swift identification** of pupils in public spaces, this neat appearance projects a solid and professional institutional image of which the entire educational community can be proud.

SAFETY

At Escola Internacional de Torres Vedras, the safety and wellbeing of the entire school community are key priorities.

Our campus enjoys a privileged and secluded location, fully enclosed by a perimeter fence and with access control at the outer gate, which makes it significantly more difficult for unauthorised persons to enter and for pupils to leave unaccompanied.

To further enhance everyone's safety, we have a modern access control system featuring **digital turnstiles at the main entrance**.

This system is strictly configured to ensure that no pupil can leave the premises unaided during school hours (between 9h15 and 16h30).

Every pupil (from Year 1 onwards) has an individual access card to pass through the turnstiles. **New pupils** should go to the LED room during their first week at school to have their photograph taken for the card.

In addition to this technology, we have staff present and providing constant supervision in the access areas throughout the day, particularly at peak times for arrivals, departures and school transport.

These integrated measures enable us to know precisely and in real time who is on campus, ensuring a calm, safe and monitored learning environment that is prepared for any eventuality.

OBTAIN PORTUGUESE DOCUMENTATION

Request for Tax Identification Number (NIF), Social Security Number (NISS) and Health Number (SNS) (simultaneously)

You must meet the following conditions:

- Have a Portuguese address;
- Not possess a Portuguese citizen's card.

You must also meet one (1) of the following conditions:

- Have applied for or already obtained a residence permit;
- Be a national of a European Union (EU) country;
- Have applied for international protection (including asylum seekers and beneficiaries of subsidiary protection);
- Have refugee status or be a beneficiary of international protection.

Simultaneous applications can only be made at 12 Citizen Service Centres nationwide. These are listed in the link below.

5 Transport & Connectivity

By Car

- Torres Vedras is connected to Lisbon via the A8 motorway (~45 minutes).
- Local parking is generally available in shopping areas and town centre streets.



By Bus & Train

- **Buses:** Barraqueiro, FlixBus, Rede Expressos - frequent services to Lisbon and neighbouring towns.
- **Trains:** The Linha do Oeste connects Torres Vedras to Lisbon and the regions to the north.
- **Tip:** If you commute to work every day, bear in mind the proximity of the bus or train station when choosing where to live.

Taxis & Shuttles

- Reliable 24h taxi services are available for local travel or airport transfers.

6 Housing & Utilities

- **Rental process:** Most rentals require a 1-to-2-month deposit, plus proof of income or guarantor.
- **Utilities:** Electricity, water, and internet are typically separate from rent. Common providers: EDP (electricity), Águas de Torres Vedras (water), and MEO/Vodafone/NOS (internet & TV).
- **Tipping point:** Make sure to register for "Número de Contribuinte" (NIF) - Portugal's tax number - as it's often needed for leases, utilities, and bank accounts.

- **Beaches:** Santa Cruz, Praia Azul, and Praia da Formosa are all nearby - clean, family-friendly, and excellent for weekend outings.
- **Parks & outdoor spaces:** Parque Verde da Várzea is a large green area ideal for walking, cycling, or picnics.
- **Culture:** Torres Vedras is known for its Carnival (one of Portugal's biggest) and historic sites like the castle and Lines of Torres fortifications.
- **Sport & recreation:** Several local gyms, swimming pools, surf schools, and tennis clubs welcome families.

- English-speaking staff are often available in private hospitals and larger pharmacies.
